Northern Rockies Early Years Programs offer play-based programs with trained and experienced staff who provide young children with an ideal environment in which to explore, create, discover, learn and grow. The goal is to help children build on their physical, emotional, social, intellectual and linguistic development in an inclusive environment.

In our Early Years Programs, we introduce pre-literacy and pre-numeracy activities to support your child's development and education readiness skills. The curriculum we use in the Northern Rockies Early Years Programs is the "Get Set for School" It was developed by Jan Olsen and Emily Knapton who are Occupational Therapists. This Pre-K curriculum is developmentally designed for children to build a strong foundation for starting their education. Get Set for School uses music and movement to engage children to learn as they play, colour, draw, count, build and sing. The concepts taught through the Get Set for School Curriculum are designed to build on each skill as it is learned. We start using the basic curriculum in our two-year-old program and progress through to kindergarten entry. Even children who do not enter our program until four years of age will benefit from the skills learned from this curriculum.

Some concepts we will be teaching are:

- Recognizing letters and numbers
- Learning habits for writing capitals and numbers (start at the top!)
- Sorting objects by size, colour, and other attributes
- Counting, sorting, creating patterns
- Building vocabulary
- Crayon grip
- Left/ Right awareness
- Body awareness
- Self Regulation
- Following directions
- Following routines
- Adaptive Skills

Not all children are the same! As all parents know, a child may excel in one area of development but not another. As well, children's innate temperaments, their likes and dislikes, and their ways of learning and doing things may be very different.

In the Northern Rockies Early Years Programs, our staff excel at getting to know young children as individuals in order to provide them with the best possible opportunities to learn and have fun. We do not design activities with rigid rules based simply on what a chart says a child should be able to do at a particular age. Nor do we prevent them from doing something the way they want, within reason. We do not structure their learning and play in a set way unless

we have a very good reason to do so. Those children who are found to require some extra supports will find that support available in their classroom as needed.

We can also expand on what a child is learning by challenging them with a new activity. We draw the child's attention in gradually interesting ways that are natural and appealing to the child.

As Early Childhood Educators, we know that there is no such thing as a "bad child" and that many behavioural issues identified in preschoolers stem from a child communicating a need. Our staff are trained and supported in identifying your child's unique need and working collaboratively to meet those needs and create an optimal learning environment for everyone. Moreover, by having a higher staff-to-child ration, children are not rushed and get a lot of attention in our programs.

Financial Obligation / Withdrawal Agreement

We accept etransfers, checks, cash, or money order. We do not accept credit cards or debit cards. A \$50 NSF charge will be charged to you on any returned checks.

This agreement will exist from June 1, 2023 to August 31, 2024. It is our goal to keep our tuition as low as possible while maintaining the excellence of the program to which we are committed in the face of rising costs.

We would like you to know the following:

1. An annual \$50 non-refundable registration/supply fee to cover the cost of consumable supplies is required with each registration form.
2. Fees are annually based and then divided into 10 months.
 - The Northern Rockies Early Years: Preschool Readiness will be closed for all stat holidays and closed for SD81school holidays. (These closures have been incorporated into your annual cost. No refund will be provided)
 - The Northern Rockies Early Years: Preschool Readiness - December rates are pro-rated to account for the 2 week holiday closure
 - The Preschool Readiness - March rates are prorated to account for a 1 week March break closure
 - A reduction of fees per class will be provided on your following months invoice for any unscheduled closures by the Northern Rockies Early Years Programs: Preschool Readiness
3. The Preschool Readiness Program does not qualify for any government fee reductions or childcare benefits (Subsidy).
4. The preferred method of payment is by etransfer to

5. We also accept cash, checks and money orders with no additional charge.
6. All payments are due by the fifth of the month and must be made no later than the 10th.
7. If you are withdrawing your child, you must notify us by the 15th of the previous month. As we do not pro-rate monthly fees.
8. If you notify us of your child's withdraw later than the 15th of the previous month: Childcare and Preschool you will be charged a "late notice fee" of 50% of your regular monthly fees.

9. In an effort to keep costs down, we email monthly invoices/ receipts.
10. If tuition fees are 60 days overdue, with no connection with the Northern Rockies Early Years Programs Manager your child's space will be given up to the waitlist.

IN CONSIDERATION OF the covenants and agreements contained in this Agreement and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties to this Agreement agree as follows:

Consideration

1. Being of lawful age and in consideration of being permitted to participate in the activity described below, the Participant releases and forever discharges the Activity Provider, the Activity Provider's spouse, heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns from all manner of actions, causes of action, debts, accounts, bonds, contracts, claims and demands for or by reason of any injury to person or property, including injury resulting in the death of the Participant, which has been or may be sustained as a consequence of the Participant's participation in the activity described below, and notwithstanding that such damage, loss or injury may have been caused solely or partly by the negligence of the Activity Provider.

2. The Participant understands that the Participant would not be permitted to participate in the activity described below unless the Participant signed this Agreement.

Details of Activity

3. The Participant will participate in the following activity:
Northern Rockies Early Years Programs: Preschool Readiness Program June 1, 2023 to August 31, 2024.

Concurrent Release

4. The Participant acknowledges that this Agreement is given with the express intention of effecting the extinguishment of certain obligations owed to the Participant and with the intention of binding the Participant's spouse, heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives and assigns.

Fitness to Participate

5. The Participant acknowledges that the Participant does not have any physical limitations, medical ailments, physical or mental disabilities that would limit or prevent the Participant from participating in the above mentioned activity. If required, the Participant will obtain a medical examination and clearance.

Full and Final Settlement

6. The Participant hereby acknowledges and agrees that the Participant has carefully read this Agreement, that the Participant fully understands the same, and that the Participant is freely and voluntarily executing the same.

7. The Participant understands that by signing this Agreement, the Participant agrees to be forever prevented from suing or otherwise claiming against the Activity Provider for any property loss or personal injury that the Participant may sustain while participating in or preparing for the above noted activity.

8. The Participant has been given the opportunity and has been encouraged to seek independent legal advice prior to signing this Agreement.

9. This Agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties to this Agreement and the terms of this Agreement are contractual and not a mere recital.

Governing Law

10. This Agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia.
